Before you begin: Please ensure you are not using "Parental Control" filters on your device or internet equipment.


Step 1

Please <u>click on the link</u> we have provided to you via Email to begin.

This will open in your default browser

For demonstration purposes, we are using **Google** Chrome.

Once clicked, the browser will **automatically** look to begin the download, please "**Save**" the .exe file if prompted.




Step 2


- Please click and open the downloaded .exe file.
- If Windows prompts you if you are sure you wish to open the installer, please click "OK" to continue.

Note: Rest assured, our apps are confirmed safe & run through rigorous checks for viruses/spyware/malware before every release.

- If Windows blocks the installation, please tap "More Info"
- Now click "Run anyway"


inCompass App will begin to configure, please allow a minute for this to complete.


If you are asked to sign in, please enter the <u>email address</u> you used to sign up on the Panel.


Step 5

Installing web browser extensions

inCompass App will detect the compatible browsers installed on your device and will guide you on installing the relevant extension.

Note: Microsoft Internet Explorer or Microsoft Edge is not supported on this Panel.




Step 6

Install Google Chrome Extension (if installed)


 Click '<u>Next</u>", this will open the Chrome browser app.



• When our Chrome extension page has loaded, click "Add to Chrome" and then "Add Extension".



 The extension is now added, please return back to the inCompass App setup window and tap 'Next'.





Step 7

Install Mozilla Firefox Extension (if installed)


 Click '<u>Next</u>", this will open the Firefox browser app.



• When our Firefox extension page has loaded, click "Continue to installation" and then "Add".



Please go back to the inCompass App setup window and click 'Next', the app will now start.








Make sure the inCompass App icon is visible along the taskbar!

Windows is set up by default to show you 3 icons only and offer a "show hidden icons" button like \rightarrow $\stackrel{\triangle}{\rightarrow}$ to see other apps running.


To make sure the inCompass app icon is present please carry out the following on your laptop/desktop:



Tip 2

Google Chrome users only: Make the inCompass browser extension visible

Please open "Google Chrome" browser



- 1 On the right of "inCompass" click the extension icon " icon on the right of the address bar.
- 2 Click on pin extension icon " ".".

Tip 3

Instructing your internet security to allow inCompass Application

Remember if you are running **third party internet security software** (e.g. *AVG, McAfee, Norton etc*), please remember to **manually add the inCompass Application** into the "<u>Allowed</u>" / "<u>Safe</u>" / "<u>Trusted</u>" / "<u>Exceptions</u>" list in your security application in order to prevent issues with compliance.


You should now see when you open inCompass App, "Configured"
